

November Meeting Summary

Larry Tipton opened the meeting at about 6:40 and welcomed the members and guests who came out this evening. He covered the standard administrative remarks and details in his opening remarks. He then did a quick update on a couple of ongoing photography-related events; both at the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts:

- American, born Hungary: Kertész, Capa, and the Hungarian American Photographic Legacy, Oct 5, 2024–Jan 26, 2025.
- A Long Arc: Photography and the American South since 1845 Oct 5, 2024–Jan 26, 2025.

Ken Cox updated the members on the current status of the Club Board. There was a short discussion on who might consider agreeing to fill our vacancies, with two members volunteering to serve on the Board for 2025: Dick Menendez as Treasurer and James Griffiths as Secretary. Their names were put forward to the assembled members and were unanimously approved via a voice vote.

Our presentation for the meeting was a dual presentation from Pablo Brown and Juan Giraud (G Man). Their topic was "The Business of Doing Business". In a wide ranging, tag team format, they covered a detailed assortment of crucial elements that any photographer who wants to run their own business has to consider in order to be successful.

With no particular emphasis on any one particular item, Pablo and G shared their personal experiences in the following areas: Marketing, business plans, pricing, financial record keeping, a professional portfolio of work, social media, professional equipment and software, legal contracting, niche styles, networking and insurance. There were comments from the members who are also in the photography business, validating the pair's point and supplementing the discussion with pertinent examples of their own.

All in all, it was a unique look into the world of being a photographic professional and provided insights beyond just the thoughts of making images.

The group then took a break and voted on this month's Photo Challenge entries. The topic was Cars.

After the final count, the results were: 1st – Dick Menendez; 2nd [tie] – John K. Rooney and James Griffiths. [Their photos are on the cover and page 2.]
