







#### **September Meeting Summary**

Larry Tipton opened the meeting at about 6:45 and welcomed the members and guests who came out this evening. He covered the standard administrative remarks and details in his opening remarks.

Larry then did a quick update on a couple of photography-related events coming up in October:

- 19th Annual Richmond Zombie Walk, Saturday, October 26th, 2024, 1:00 – 3:00 pm.
- American, born Hungary: Kertész, Capa, and the Hungarian American Photographic Legacy Oct 5, 2024–Jan 26, 2025 and A Long Arc: Photography and the American South since 1845 Oct 5, 2024–Jan 26, 2025, both at the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts

Ken Cox then took some time to hold an open forum about our recent Lasting Impressions 2024 show here at PAAL. The members were open with their comments and suggestions, which mostly centered around the fact that the show was an "open show" without categories and the judging of the show. In the end, there were a significant number of valuable take-aways that will definitely be addressed before the next show. The real bottom line from the forum was there needs to be communication and sharing of information among the members, with inputs considered and incorporated.

Larry then addressed the current status of the Club Board. With Daniel Jones' resignation as President and Pablo Brown's intention to relinquish the Treasurer's position in December, we need to find new candidates to fill those vacancies. There will be an open discussion at the October meeting and the Club will vote in November to see who might fill all the positions on the Board.

Next Ken led the members present through a bit of an exercise where those present were asked to be judges for the evening. Each was given a voting ballot and asked to look at the Lasting Impressions exhibit and then to individually vote for their first three places – mimicking the process our judge went through. All took it in good spirits, with the results being widely divergent! There were certainly some consistencies, but in the end it became apparent that it was not easy to judge and rank the show entries.

The group then took a break and voted on this month's Photo Challenge entries. The topic was Lights. The results were: 1<sup>st</sup> – Larry Tipton; 2<sup>nd</sup> – Crystal Phelps; 3<sup>rd</sup> – Dick Menendez. [Their photos are on the cover and page 2.]

As a last order of business before we concluded the meeting, the Photo Challenge topic for October was chosen: **Numbers**.

### **September Treasurer's Report**

- A. Cockade City Camera Club (CCCC) held its monthly regular membership meeting on September 26, 2024. In that meeting, one member renewed their membership to cover dues for calendar year 2025 and 2026. A direct member dues payment by cash was made in the amount \$40.00. The club's rate for single membership is \$20 each and family memberships at \$30 each.


#### **Next Meeting**
