#### **November Meeting Summary**

The meeting was called to order at 6:45 by Larry Tipton with 18 people in attendance.

Larry opened the meeting with some standard administrative remarks

This month's meeting was about the Club itself and was a chance to discuss some recent changes, and to give the members an update on possible future adjustments.

The first topic was a business update which overed bylaw revisions, board restructuring, finances, and membership changes. Any Bylaw revisions aim to simplify governance; the Club's recent transition gives us a smaller, less complex structure, and bylaws revisions are under review for further streamlining. Membership renewal to revert to January cycle for administrative efficiency. This will give us a better financial picture for event and activity planning. There will be adjustments for those who joined during this past year.

Next Dick Menendez, the Treasurer, gave a financial report highlighting:

- 2025 financials combine Cockade City and Petersburg Camera Clubs; Cockade City Club now closed.
- Our expenses exceed our income; projected year-end balance drops from \$1,540 to \$995.

- Our major expenses: website renewal (\$323), rent (\$50/month), tax/accounting fees (\$375), insurance (\$300), state registration (\$100). In addition, there will be a final tax return for Cockade City Club due in early 2025; future returns not required as 501c7 non-profit.
- Fundraising and increased dues needed; proposed activities include photography classes and portrait studios; lack of promotion previously limited success.

Next we discussed our social media. Website hosting and content updates discussed, recognizing the need for more frequent updates and possible web host migration to reduce costs. The current website is updated infrequent; there are plans to add monthly winners, articles, and event info. We then had a short discussion on website value versus social media presence; website is a major expense.

We then took time to review and vote on the entries in this month's Photo Challenge. The topic was **Architecture**, but the reveal was held until the end of the program. Next, we showed the Miscellaneous Photos submitted this month. For this month images came from Jim Griffiths, John A. Rooney, Jr., Tatiana Hoosack, James Hampton-Snow, Ken Cox, Juan Giraud, Larry Tipton, Marvin Averett, Amber Smith, Tom Saunders, John K. Rooney and Tim Trauger. [See their photos on pages 5-8].

When the counting was done the winners were: 1st – Crystal Phelps; 2<sup>nd</sup> – Tatiana Hoosack; 3<sup>rd</sup> - Tim Trauger. [Look for their photos on the cover and page 2]. Then we selected the topic for the December Photo Challenge contest: **Arches**. [See the details on this page.]




